Please do not bring children onto the premises or leave them in the entrance as there is no one to supervise them.

**Infant Service** – there will be an infant service on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> March at 09.15 led by Year 2 - Mrs Hurrell, all are welcome to attend.

**Assembly** – it will be a Celebration assembly on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> March 2019, all are welcome to attend.

**Safeguarding** – the number of requests to use the toilet whilst waiting to collect children has increased. Due to safeguarding we are unable to allow people to use the toilet unless accompanied by a member of staff and as I am sure you can appreciate this is particularly difficult.

**Choir Club** – will not run until further notice.

**Uniform** – we like to pride ourselves on our school uniform but have noticed that not all children are wearing the correct uniform, please ensure that your child is wearing the correct uniform.

**Jewellery** - Studs are permissible for pierced ears, but must be removed for P.E. and swimming, teaching staff are not allowed to remove earrings.

For Health and Safety reasons, children with recently pierced ears will not be allowed to do P.E. until the wound is healed and the child is capable of removing the studs unattended.

**Hair** - Hair should be kept neat and tidy.

Long hair is to be tied back. (Headbands/elastics/clips should be plain blue or black)

No "trendy" hairstyles please, as this tends to cause rivalry and jealousy in the classroom. No hair gel/wax products.

**Make-up** - No make-up or nail varnish.

**Lost Property** – the lost property box is overflowing, if your child has lost anything please take a look. Any items left in the box at the end of the term will be removed. There are also 5 scooters that have been left behind and are currently being looked after by Mr Ellis again if they are not collected by the end of term they will be removed.
